

Mothers bridge span delivery and installation out of hours work

Wagga Wagga

18 July – 25 July 2026



The Mothers bridge site has reached an important milestone, with the main span of the new pedestrian bridge to be delivered to the Wagga Wagga railyard (Railway Street) on Saturday 18 July.

Work being done

The new 50 metre bridge span will be delivered to the Wagga Wagga railyard off Railway Street Turvey Park, on Saturday 18 July 2026. It will be moved using an oversized truck, with pilot vehicles and traffic control.

The bridge main span will be lifted into place on Thursday 23 July from 4.30pm.

When work will happen

Works will occur during standard construction hours, 7am to 6pm Monday to Saturday, in addition to out of hours works up to 10pm on the following dates:

- **7am – 10am Saturday 18 July 2026**
Delivery of the bridge section to Wagga Wagga railyard, via Railway Street, Turvey Park.
- **7am -10pm Wednesday 22 July 2026**
Span installation preparation works.
- **7am-10pm Thursday 23 July 2026**
Lifting and installation of the bridge section onto the new bridge supports.

Temporary Mothers bridge access restriction

On Thursday 23 July 2026, Mothers bridge access will be temporarily restricted to the public while the bridge span is lifted into place. The access is expected to be restricted from 4.30pm for up to an hour.

The bridge will be reopened to the public at the completion of the lift.

Dedicated bus services will be provided from Wagga Wagga Railway Station and Railway Street Turvey Park to provide connectivity during the bridge access restriction.

This bus services will be a hail and ride service, with personnel in place on Railway Street to direct people to the bus pick up point.

What can I expect?

- **18 July 2026** Traffic control, pilot vehicles and police escort will be used during the movement of the bridge span to site.
- **18 July 2026** Minor traffic delays may occur while the bridge section and crane enter the work site on Railway Street, Turvey Park.
- **23 July 2026** Temporary traffic and pedestrian detour will be in place on Railway Street between Macleay Street and Collins Street during the lift only.

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- **23 July 2026** Temporary access restrictions to Railway Place (Multicultural Centre) during the span lift.
- Professional photography including authorised drone usage over the work site only.
- Cassidy temporary scaffold bridge will remain open providing pedestrian connectivity from Cassidy Parade Turvey Park to Fox Street Wagga.
- Safety zones will be set up and monitored during the lift to keep people safe from the work area.
- Temporary traffic and pedestrian detours, please follow all signage and directions from traffic controllers and site personnel.

Community viewing area

We understand the community may be interested in watching this major milestone.

A viewing area will be set up on Railway Street, Turvey Park, where people can safely **watch the lift** from outside the work area.

Please note, the viewing area will not be accessible to the public during the delivery of the span.

No drones are permitted in the work area.

How we're managing impacts

- Delivery movements will be planned outside peak traffic times where possible.
- Traffic control, police escort and pilot vehicles will help manage the safe movement of the bridge section and plant to site.

Cancellation of works

Works may be cancelled or rescheduled at short notice due to weather or other factors.

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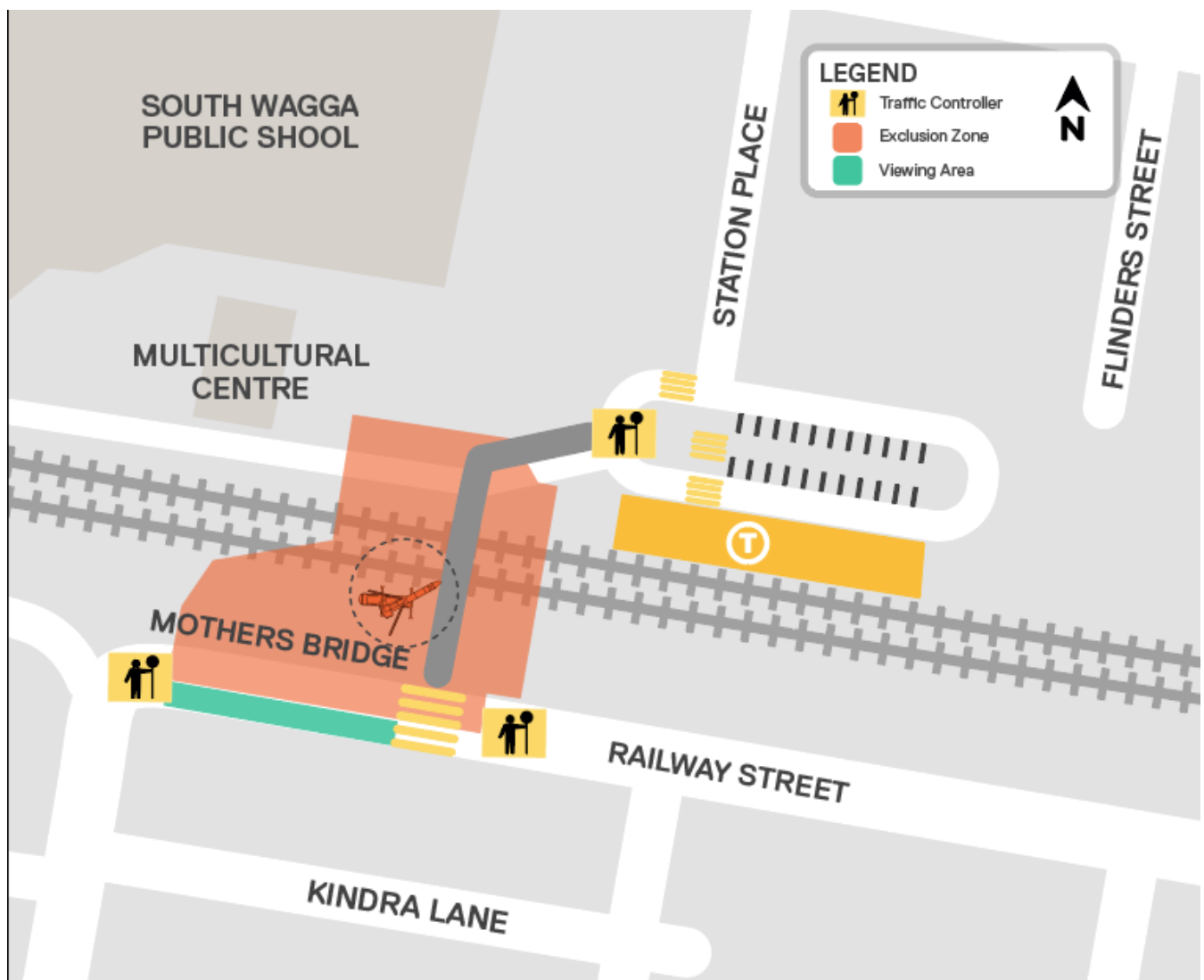


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Map: safety zone, community viewing area and traffic control

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
