

Three Month Lookahead Albury August to October 2026



Martinus will continue construction works across multiple sites in Albury from **August to October 2026**.

Hours of work

During standard construction hours of **7am to 6pm**, **Monday to Saturday**:

- Albury Yard and Riverina Highway bridge

During revised construction hours of **7am to 6pm**, **Monday to Sunday** (including public holidays):

- Billy Hughes bridge

If work is required outside these hours, affected neighbours will be notified in advance.

Work being done

- Installing drainage and concrete formwork
- Ground drilling for concrete piling
- Signalling and track-related works
- Earthworks and ground excavations
- Grubbing and vegetation removal
- Operating the temporary site compound
- Environmental monitoring, survey and track inspections
- Removing materials and debris off-site
- Construction material and equipment deliveries

What can I expect?

- Heavy vehicles operating at several work sites
- Reduced speed limit of 40km/h near works, where required
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration
- On-site traffic management, where required. Please follow all instructions and signage

Machinery used

Equipment includes but is not limited to hand tools, mobile crane, hi-rail machinery, oxy cutter, hydraulic hammer, concrete pump, concrete trucks, generators, plate compactor, drum rollers, semi-trucks, loaders, EWP (elevated work platform), vibrating rollers, excavators, water carts, survey equipment, skid steer, power washer, heavy and light vehicles.

How we're managing impacts

- Water carts on-site to dampen the ground and help manage dust
- Non-tonal reversing alarms will be used on all equipment, and equipment will be switched off when not in use
- Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum and show respect for our neighbours
- The works will be monitored to ensure compliance with Project Conditions of Approval (CoAs) and adherence to the requirements outlined in the Environment Protection Licence (EPL 21984).

Cancellation of works

Work may be cancelled at short notice due to weather and other factors. If this happens, work will be rescheduled and affected neighbours will be notified in advance.

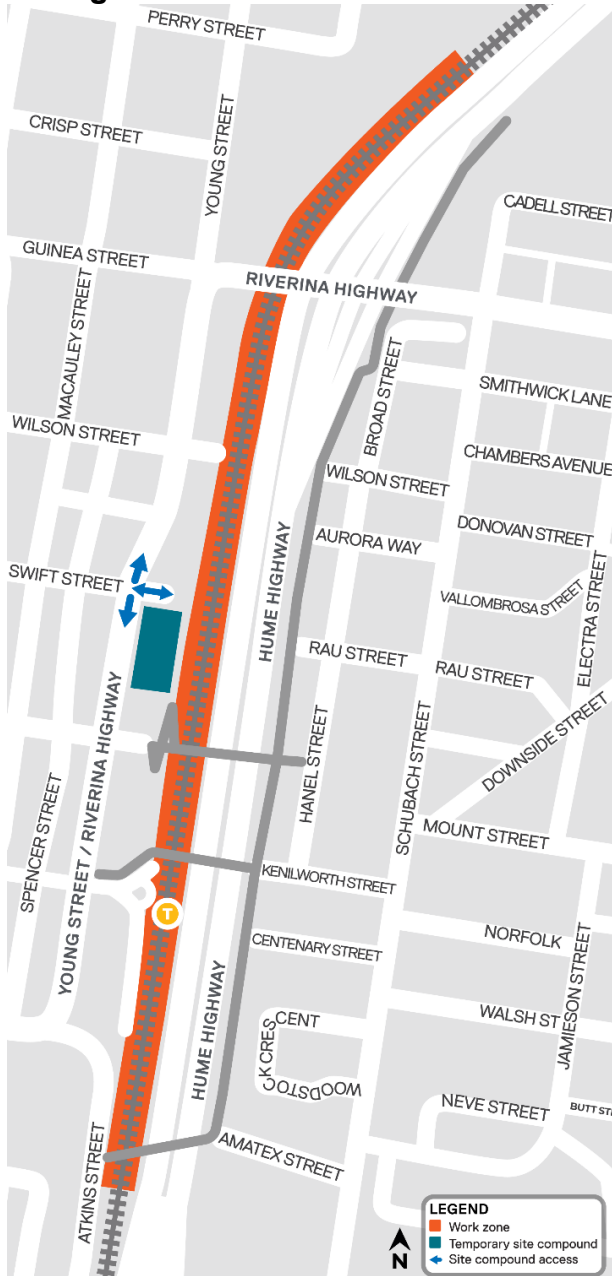


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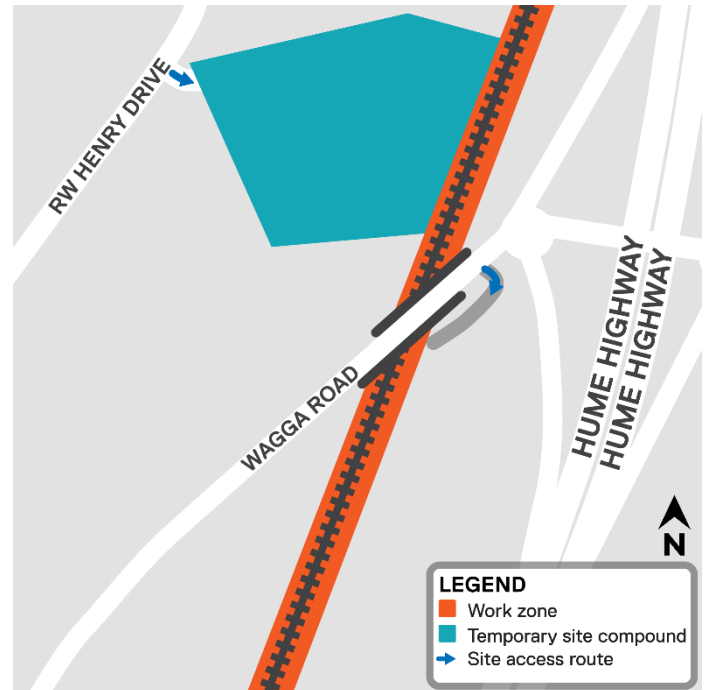
