John Holland will continue works across Broadford during August, including construction of the new Marchbanks Road bridge.

Work being done

Marchbanks Road

- Piling works
- Construction of abutment and L-walls
- Construction of hardstands and access tracks
- Earthworks
- Drainage works.

Hamilton Street and Short Street

- Landscaping and reinstatement works.

What can I expect?

Marchbanks

- Round-the-clock works
- **Marchbanks Road bridge and Hume Freeway on/off ramps will be temporarily closed from Sunday 16 August until mid-October to demolish the existing bridge and build the new bridge**
- Single-lane shuttle flow over the Marchbanks Road bridge until Sunday 16 August
- Please refer to electronic signage for up-to-date traffic changes and any road or bridge closure details, allow additional travel time, and follow all detour signage and traffic management
- Nearby residents may experience some noise, lighting from light towers and vibration.

Hamilton Street and Short Street

- **Works 7am-6pm Monday to Friday and 7am-1pm Saturdays**
- Temporary short-term shuttle flow, as required

- Access to Short Street from Sutherland Street and Rupert Street (east) will be temporarily closed
- The closure at the intersection of Burges Lane and Cameron Parade has been reinstated
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration.

Machinery used

Trucks, excavators, piling rigs, elevated work platforms, loaders, graders, concrete pump, asphalt paver, telehandler and cranes. Workers using hand tools and traffic management equipment.

How we're managing impacts

- Traffic management and reduced road speeds
- Environmental controls in place.

Cancellation or extension of works

Works can sometimes take longer than anticipated or be cancelled at short notice and rescheduled. Should this occur, impacted residents will be updated.

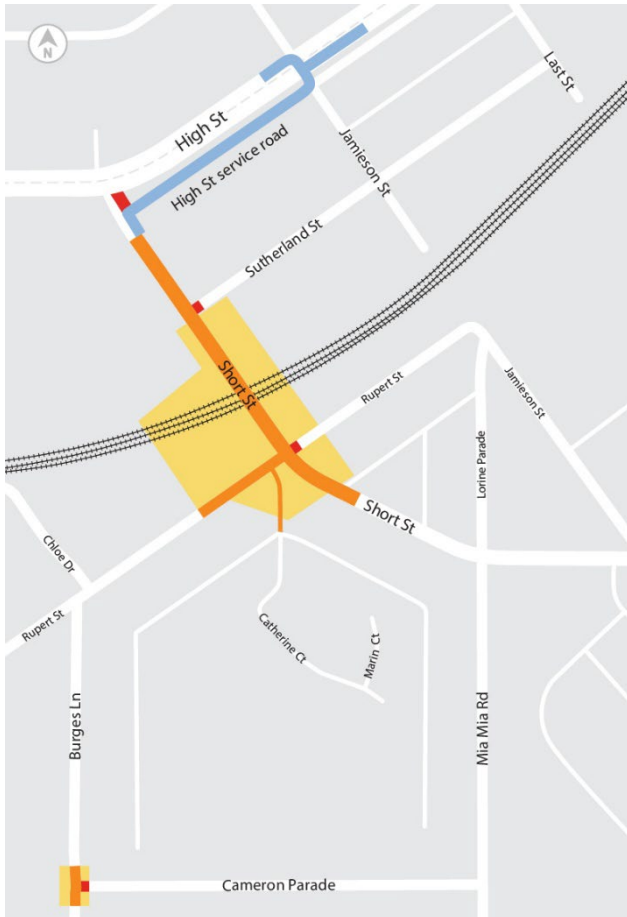

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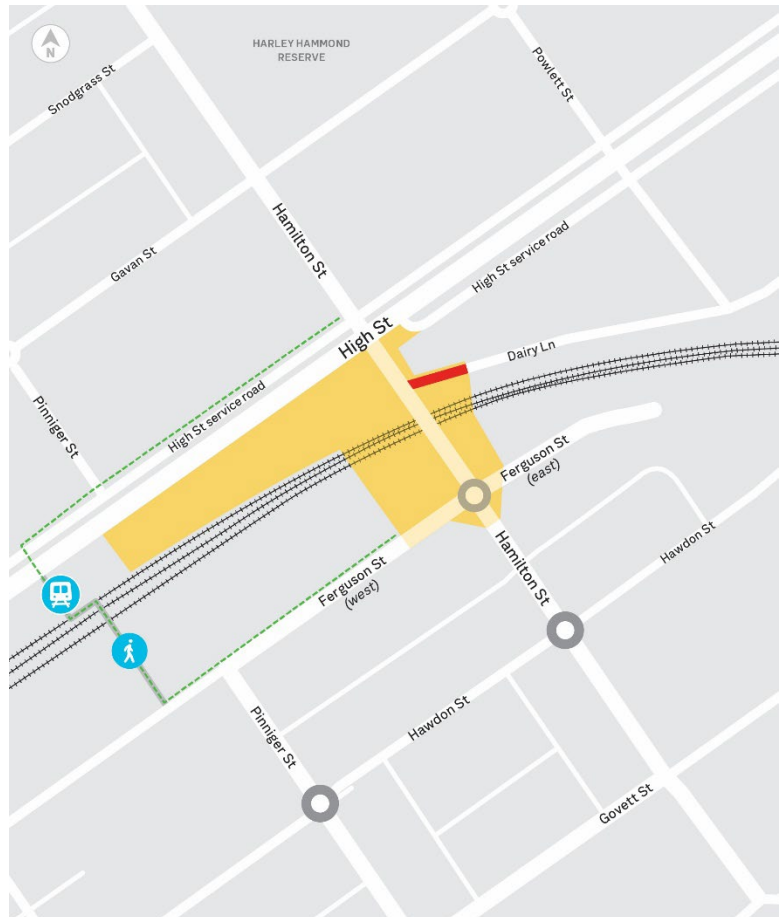
Short Street

- Pedestrian detour

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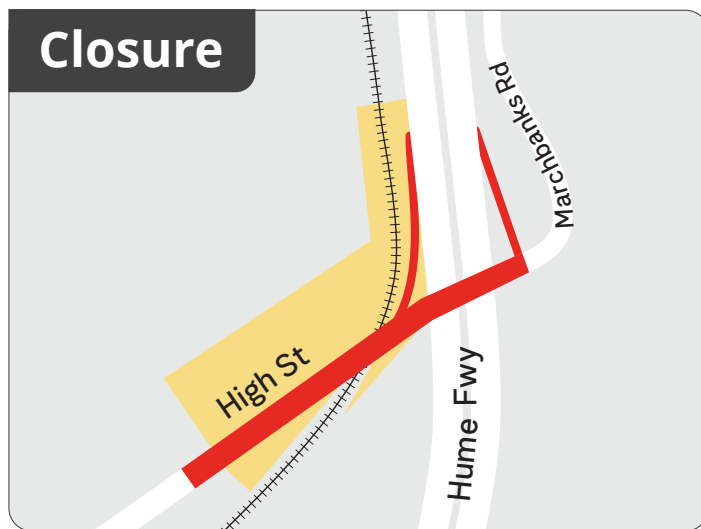

What's happening across Broadford Marchbanks Road bridge closure

Sunday 16 August to mid-October

Inland Rail is replacing the Marchbanks Road bridge with a new higher bridge to provide sufficient clearance for double-stacked freight trains.

- A detour will be in place via the Hume Freeway Clonbinane interchange.
- Refer to electronic signage for up-to-date traffic changes and road closure details. Follow all detour signage and traffic management.
- Allow an additional 15–20 minutes travel time when using detours.

Works can sometimes be delayed or rescheduled due to inclement weather or other factors.

Should these closures be impacted or delayed, local residents and businesses will be updated.
