

Out of Hours Work Yerong Creek August to September 2026

Martinus will undertake works outside their standard construction hours at Yerong Creek on the following dates and times:

- **8am to 6pm on Sunday, 23 August 2026**
- **8am to 6pm on Sunday, 30 August 2026**
- **7am to 8pm on Thursday, 3 September 2026**
- **8am to 6pm on Sunday, 6 September 2026**

Work being done

- Signalling testing and commissioning
- Operating the temporary site compound
- Excavating ground and track works
- Installing drainage
- Delivering construction materials and equipment to the site
- Environmental monitoring, surveying and track inspections.

What can I expect?

- Heavy vehicles operating at several work sites
- Reduced speed limit of 40km/h near works, where required
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration
- On-site traffic management, where required. Please follow all instructions and signage.

Machinery used

Equipment includes but is not limited to hand-powered tools, loaders, semi-trucks, generators, drum rollers, excavators, compactors, hi-rail machinery, mechanical tamper, lightning towers, water carts, vacuum truck, grinders, survey equipment, heavy and light vehicles.

How we're managing impacts

- Works are scheduled to minimise noise impacts where possible
- Water carts on-site to dampen the ground and help manage dust
- Non-tonal reversing alarms will be used on all equipment, and equipment will be switched off when not in use
- Traffic controls, where required, to ensure vehicle and pedestrian safety
- Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum and show respect to our neighbours
- The works will be monitored to ensure compliance with the Project Conditions of Approval (CoAs) and the Environment Protection Licence (EPL 21984).

Cancellation of works

Work may be cancelled at short notice due to weather and other factors. If this happens, work will be rescheduled and affected neighbours will be notified in advance.

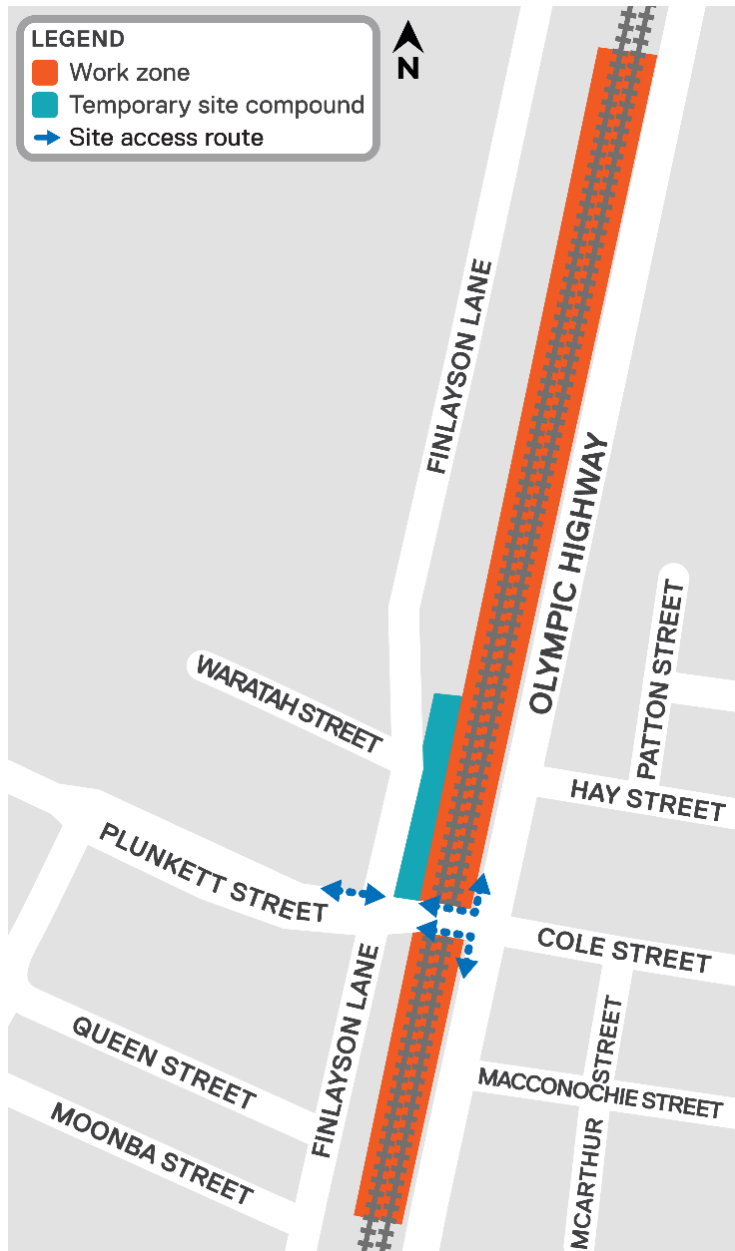


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Location of work
