

# Out of Hours Work Albury September 2026



Martinus will undertake out-of-hours works at various sites in Albury during an extended track possession from **6pm on Friday, 11 September to 11:59pm on Tuesday, 15 September 2026.**

These works will be continuous, including night work during this period.

Track possessions are critical to the project, as no trains will run during this period. This helps us complete our work faster and minimise disruption to the community.

## Work being done

- Installing drainage
- Signalling and track-related works
- Excavating ground and earthworks
- Tamping, also known as mechanised track surfacing
- Installing steel girders and support structures for the new footbridge at Albury station
- Drilling ground for concrete piling
- Removing materials and debris off-site
- Delivering construction equipment and materials to the site
- Surveying, environmental monitoring and track inspections.

## What can I expect?

- Heavy vehicles operating at several work sites
- Reduced speed limit of 40km/h near works, where required
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration
- On-site traffic management, where required. Please follow all instructions and signage.

## Machinery used

Equipment includes but is not limited to hand tools, mobile crane, EWP (elevated work platform), hi-rail machinery, oxy cutter, hydraulic hammer, concrete pump, generators, plate compactor, mechanised tamper, drum rollers, semi-trucks, lightning towers, loaders, vibrating rollers, piling rig, plate compactor, excavators, water carts, survey equipment, Frana crane, skid steer, power washer, heavy and light vehicles.

## How we're managing impacts

- Water carts on-site to dampen the ground and help manage dust
- Non-tonal reversing alarms will be used on all equipment, and equipment will be switched off when not in use
- Traffic controls, where required, to ensure vehicle and pedestrian safety
- Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum and show respect for our neighbours
- The works will be monitored to ensure compliance with the Project Conditions of Approval (CoAs) and the Environment Protection Licence (EPL 21984).

## Cancellation of works

Work may be cancelled at short notice due to weather and other factors. If this happens, work will be rescheduled and affected neighbours will be notified in advance.

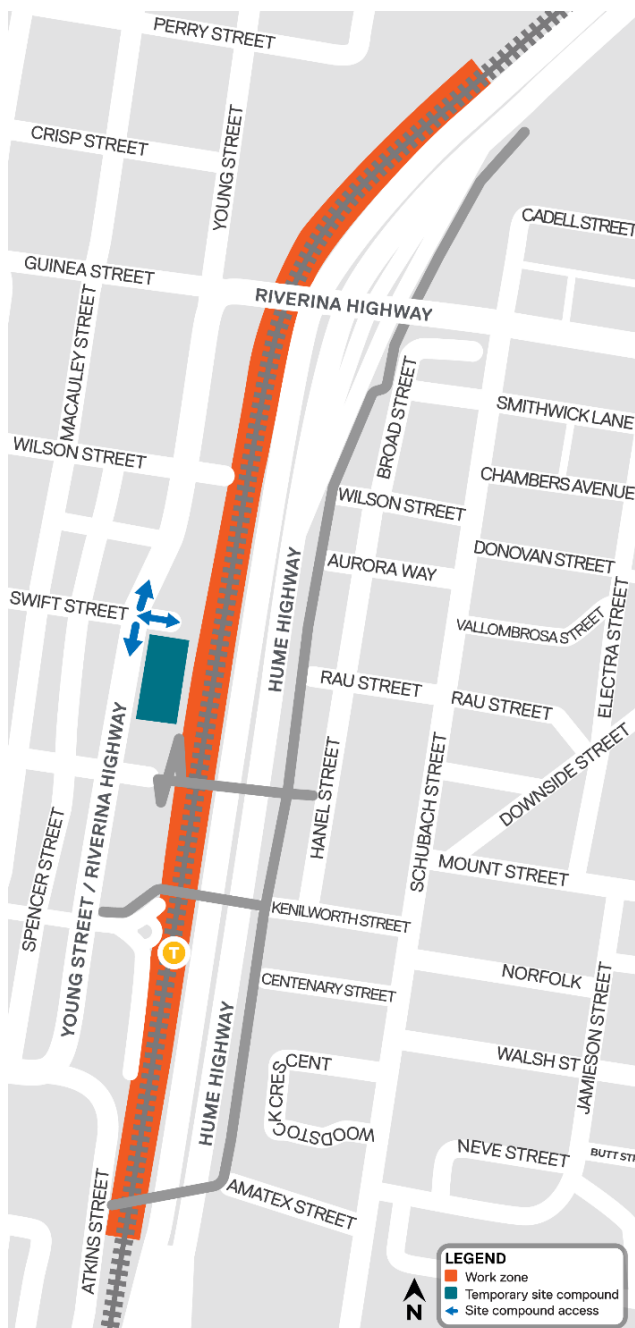
