

Construction Update

Kenilworth Street, Albury

August to October 2026



Martinus will commence construction works at the end of Kenilworth Street, Albury from **Monday 24 August** to **Saturday 31 October 2026**.

Hours of work

During standard construction hours of **7am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday**.

If work is required outside these hours, affected neighbours will be notified in advance.

Work being done

- Excavating ground and earthwork
- Removing vegetation, where required
- Drilling ground for concrete piling
- Constructing retaining wall and ramps
- Installing drainage
- Removing materials and debris off-site
- Delivering construction equipment and materials
- Environmental monitoring and surveying.

What can I expect?

- The Albury-Thurgoona trail at the end of Kenilworth Street will be partially closed with temporary diversions in place during construction. Safe access for all trail users around the work area will be maintained at all times
- Reduced speed limit of 40km/h on Kenilworth Street, where required
- Temporary parking disruptions on Kenilworth Street, while we carry out these works
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration
- On-site traffic management, where required. Please follow all instructions and signage.

Machinery used

Equipment includes but is not limited to hand tools, mobile crane, demolition machinery, oxy cutter, concrete pump, concrete trucks, generators, plate compactor, semi-trucks, loaders, EWP (elevated work platform), vibrating rollers, excavators, water carts, survey equipment, skid steer, power washer, heavy and light vehicles.

How we're managing impacts

- Non-tonal reversing alarms will be used on all equipment, and equipment will be switched off when not in use
- Traffic controls, where required, to ensure vehicle and pedestrian safety
- Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum and show respect for our neighbours
- Water carts on-site to dampen the ground and help manage dust
- The works will be monitored to ensure compliance with the Project Conditions of Approval (CoAs) and the Environment Protection Licence (EPL 21984).

Cancellation of works

Work may be cancelled at short notice due to weather and other factors. If this happens, work will be rescheduled and affected neighbours will be notified in advance.

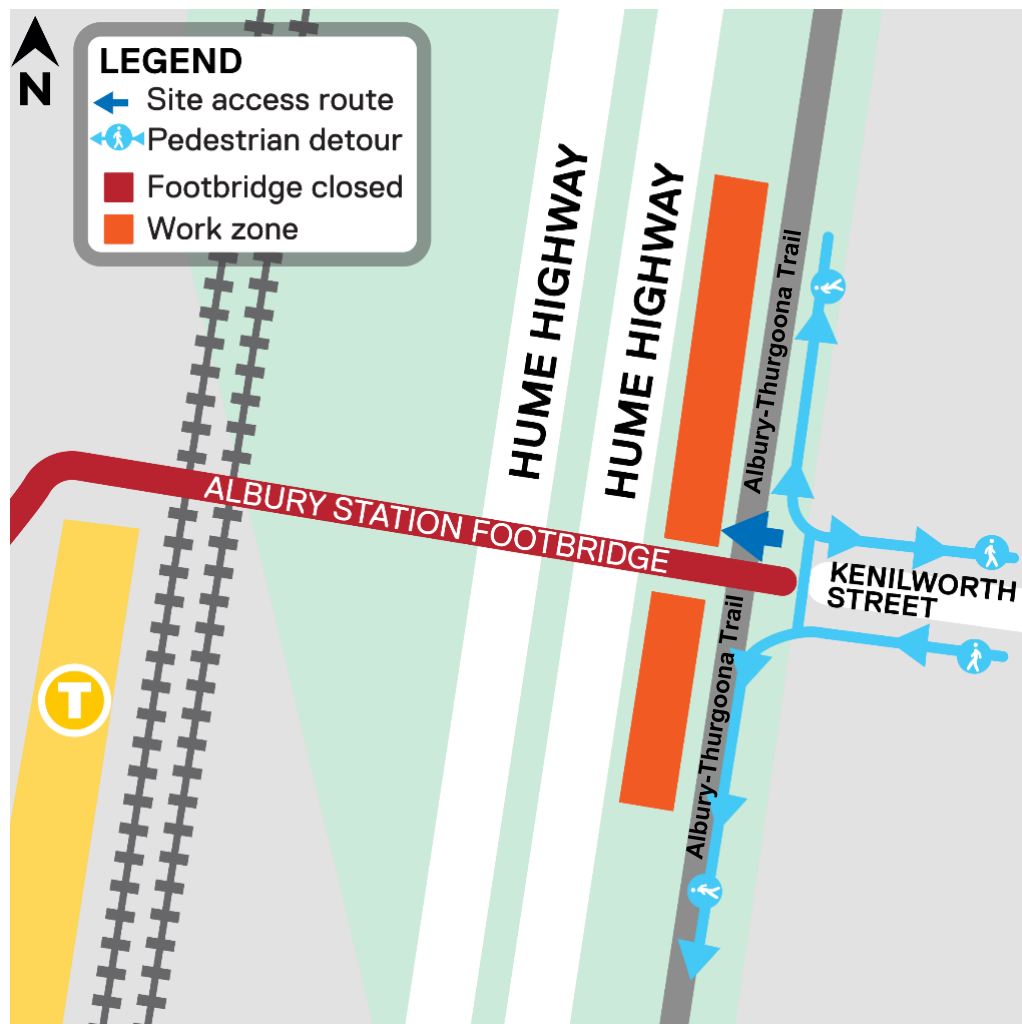


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Location of work
