Kemp Street bridge

To support bridge construction, deliveries of steel girders will be undertaken during both standard construction hours, and out-of-hours work periods.

Standard construction hour deliveries

(7am – 6pm Monday to Saturday)

- Monday 3 August to Wednesday 5 August
- Monday 31 August to Wednesday 2 September
- Monday 28 September until Thursday 1 October

Out-of-hours construction

Girder Delivery:

- 3 August – Monday 6pm – 10pm

Sewer relocation works:

Sewer relocation works will occur along inside the Kemp Street compound near Seignior Street

- 23 August – Sunday 6pm until Monday 7am
- 24 August – Monday 6pm until Tuesday 7am
- 26 August – Wednesday 6pm until Thursday 7am (contingency)
- 27 August – Thursday 6pm until Friday 7am (contingency)

Construction activities:

- Night shift sewer works during the low flow period. Waste trucks to transport materials during cutover. Excavation plant and personnel to perform the cutover. Lighting towers and generators to be set up for night works.
- **Steel girders to be delivered during August and September. Delivery will occur next to the rail corridor on Hill Street and Edgar Street. Near the Junee Skate Park.**
During these periods Hill Street between Edgar and Ducker Street will remain under traffic control.
- Deliveries of a 450-tonne crane, medium rigid truck and up to 10 B-Double trucks.(all under escort)
- Limited street parking will be available on Hill Street between Edgar Street and Ducker Street.
- This street will remain under traffic control during this period.
- Crane setup will start on the corner of Hill and Edgar Street once delivered (estimated to take approximately 2 hours)
- Temporary fencing to be installed
- Pedestrian access to businesses on Hill Street will remain open
- **From August 18** Kemp Street site compound will increase in size to cover part of Endeavour Park. Pedestrian access will be maintained via Kemp Street, Joffree Street, into Endeavour Park and then rejoin back on Seignior Street. Refer to map overleaf.
- Asbestos removal may be necessary. Where identified, removals will be carried out by a licensed contractor with SafeWork NSW regulations and industry best practices. Strict safety measures will be in place to ensure there is no risk to community or the environment.
- Abutment, pavement, kerb & footpath excavation, demolition and loadout
- Access track construction
- Survey works
- Geotechnical investigations

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INLAND RAIL



- Contamination testing and remediation works (if encountered)
- Construction of concrete bridge piers, retaining walls and other substructure elements
- Installation of bridge superstructure spans and elements such as parapets, throw screens
- Bridge deck pours
- Installation of temporary road signage, fencing, barriers and scaffolding.
- Drainage and earthworks
- Utility investigation and relocation works including sewer main works
- Vegetation trimming, clearing and grubbing
- Traffic control will be in place as needed
- Retaining wall construction

Traffic Detours

Stage 3 vehicle detours will be implemented from 18 August 2026 until project completion.

- Seignior Street will be partly closed; however the service road will remain open **for local traffic only**.
- Olympic Highway (Kemp Street) between Seignior Street and Joffre Street will remain local traffic access only in a west bound direction.
- The top section Railway Parade will be closed as per the map
- Heavy Vehicle detour will be via Goldfields Way, Old Junee Road onto either Queen Street or Main Street.
- Pretoria Avenue access to Seignior Street service road will remain open for as long as possible but will be closed whilst drainage and tie in works are underway. (23 August until 24 August 2026.)

Community Shuttle

Changes to the community shuttle will be implemented from 18 August 2026 and will include:

- Seignior Street turnaround point to be shortened whilst drainage works are happening.

How we're managing impacts

- Works programmed to best minimise noise impacts.
- Use of low-tonal reversing alarms on all plant and equipment and turning off equipment when not in use.
- Instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum and being respectful of our neighbours.
- Water carts onsite to assist with dust suppression and fire risks.
- Onsite noise monitoring to be conducted to ensure compliance

Temporary traffic changes near you

- During construction, vehicle movements will be to and from site, as well as on site.
- Traffic management will be in place to safely direct traffic as needed

What can I expect

Unfortunately, some construction activities are inherently noisy which cannot be avoided. Properties near these areas can expect to hear:

- Excavation activities involving the removal of existing surfaces such as rock, soil, bridge segments, bridge abutments, existing roads and transportation of materials
- Heavy vehicle movements, geotechnical investigations and pavement coring.
- Loading, unloading and moving equipment including cranes and materials
- Construction machinery and equipment operation

Equipment list

Backhoe, ballast equipment, compactor, compressor, concrete agitator truck, elevated work platforms, excavators, front end loader, generator, grinders, hand tools, hi-rail equipment, hydraulic tools, jumping jack, lighting towers, mobile cranes, plate compactor, positrack, rail saw, road sweeper, rollers, telescopic handler, truck & dogs, light and medium rigid vehicles, vacuum trucks, watercarts.

Cancellation of works

Work may be cancelled at short notice due to weather and other factors. If this happens, work will be rescheduled and affected neighbours will be notified in advance.
