

Out of Hours Bridge Works

June

August 2026 - Update

There have been some changes to these dates since initially notified. Please see below for the latest information.

To support the safe delivery and installation of the new concrete bridge decks for Kemp Street Road bridge works are required outside of normal hours.

A 650-tonne crane will be used to lift and install a total of 16 concrete girders, the heaviest is girder weighing 48-tonne and the lightest is 44-tonne. This crane also requires deliveries of counterweights to be installed on site prior to any lifting activities.

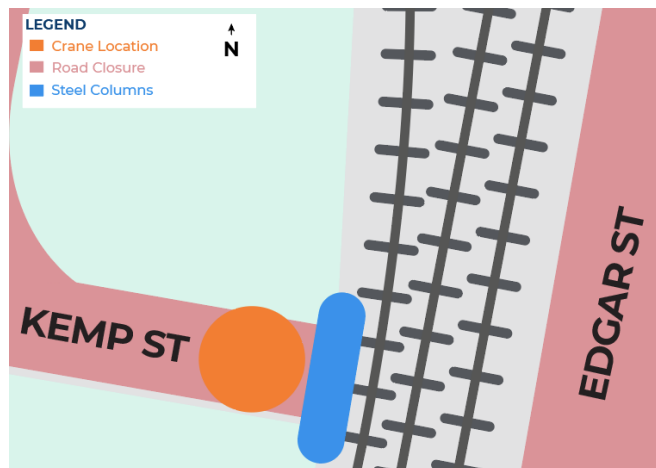
Works will occur

Works will commence during normal construction hours (7am – 6pm) and run into the evening period (out-of-hours) on the following dates:

Monday 17 – Tuesday 18 August (7am – 10pm)

Removal of the existing steel columns (soldier piles) need to happen prior to the installation of the bridge girders.

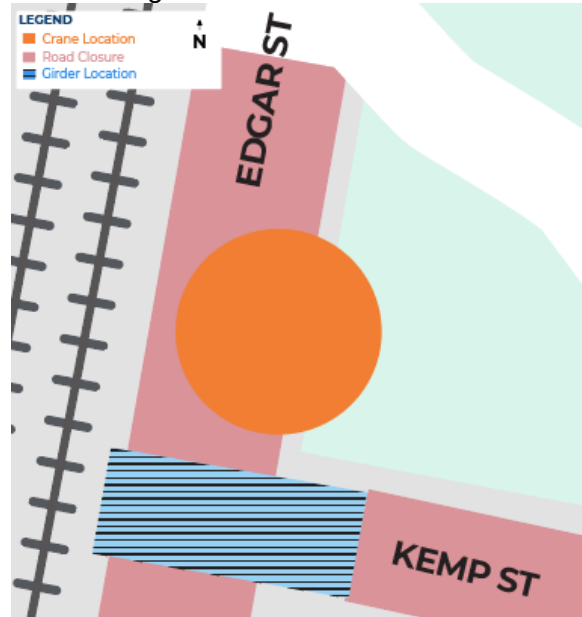
A 100-tonne mobile crane will mobilise on the eastern side of Kemp Street bridge (inside the compound), before steel columns are removed and transported off site via a flatbed truck.



Thursday 20 – Saturday 22 August (7am – 10pm)

Mobilisation of the crane along Edgar Street to prepare for installation of the girders for Kemp Street bridge.

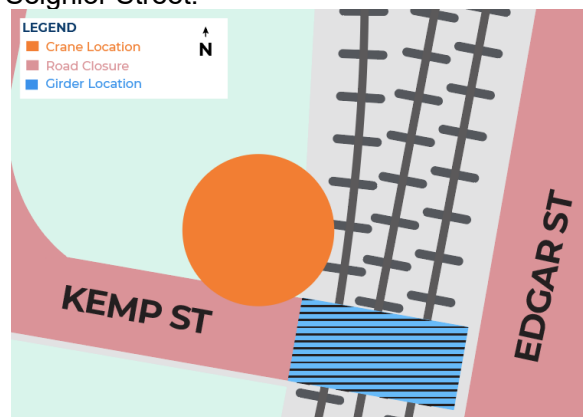
Traffic control will be in place for these dates along Hill and Edgar Streets.



Saturday 22 August (7am – 10pm), Sunday 23 August (8am -8pm) and Monday 24 August – Thursday 27 August (7am - 10pm)

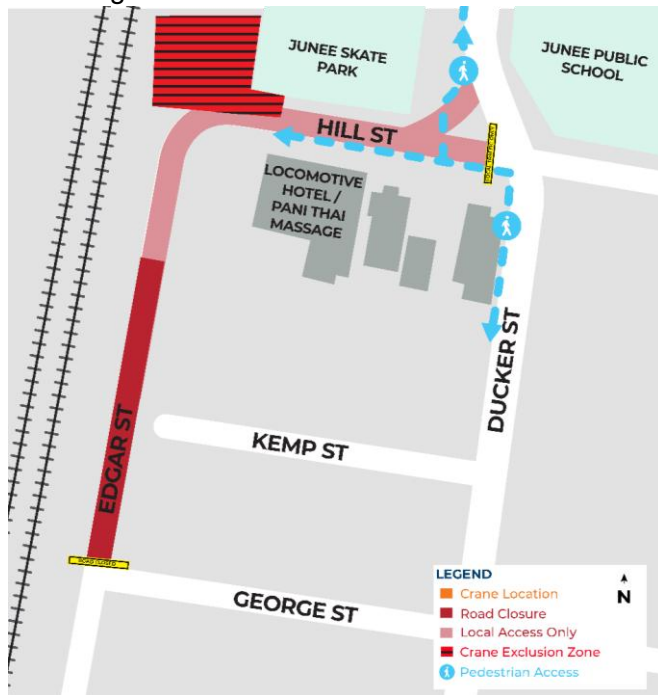
Crane will demobilise from Edgar Street and remobilise on the eastern side of Kemp Street bridge.

Traffic control will be in place for these dates along Seignior Street.



Monday 31 August– Wednesday 2 September (7am - 10pm)

Crane will remobilise onto Edgar Street to lift and install the next two steel girders of the pedestrian foot bridge.



- Approved tree trimming and clearing on the corner of Seignior Street and Pretoria Avenue.
- Instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum and being respectful of our neighbours.
- Onsite noise and vibration monitoring to be conducted to ensure compliance with our Environmental Protection Licence.
- Lighting will be directed away from residents.
- Use of traffic control and fencing / flagging to keep exclusion zones clear for safety.

Machinery used:

To complete the works safely there will be a combination 650-tonne and 100 tonne cranes, HV trucks with jinker trailers delivering counterweights and girders, lighting towers, elevated work platforms, light vehicles and hand tools.

Cancellation of works

Work may be cancelled at short notice due to weather and other factors. If this happens, work will be rescheduled and affected neighbours will be notified in advance.

What can I expect

- **Hill Street and Edgar Street will be under traffic control with local resident access only** during deliveries and closed during each girder lift off the trucks and into the corridor. (20 – 22 August 2026 and 31 August - 2 September)
- **Seignior Street will be under traffic control to facilitate crane movements into the eastern compound. (22 – 27 August 2026)**
- Limited street parking will be available on Hill Street between Edgar Street and Ducker Street between 20 August until 22 August.
- Temporary fencing / flagging to be installed around exclusion zones.
- Pedestrian access to businesses on Hill Street will remain open.
- Site compound on Seignior Street and at Wrights Oval will be in use during the out of hours activities.

How we're managing impacts

- Access will be maintained where safe to do so, with temporary changes communicated where required.
- Use of low-tonal reversing alarms on all plant and equipment and turning off equipment when not in use.
