Hume Freeway bridge, Tallarook 1 to 30 September 2026

John Holland will continue works under the Hume Freeway bridge in Tallarook during September.

Work being done

- Reinforcement of bridge abutments
- Construction of bridge deflection and protection walls
- Construction of retaining wall
- Installation of drainage
- Track lowering works on the passing loop
- Rail tamping and grinding
- Movement of materials along the haulage route
- Approved vegetation removal.

What can I expect?

- **Works 7am-7pm Monday to Friday and 7am-1pm Saturdays**
- **Round-the-clock works between 7pm Friday 11 September and 7pm Wednesday 16 September**
- **Increased truck use along Main Road and Sanctuary Road**
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and can expect additional workers, trucks and construction vehicles in the area.

How we are managing impacts

- Traffic management and reduced road speeds
- Environmental controls in place.

Machinery used

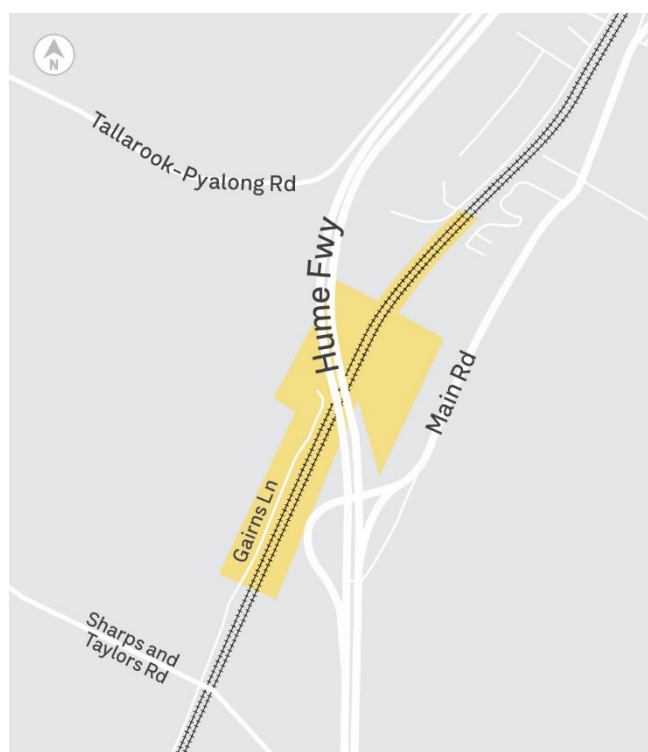
Trucks, excavators, tippers, graders, elevated work platforms, concrete trucks, hi-rail plant and cranes. Workers using hand tools and survey equipment.
