

Construction Update

Uranquinty

September to December 2026

Martinus will continue construction work at Uranquinty from **Wednesday 23 September** to **Friday 18 December 2026** between standard construction hours of **7am** and **6pm**, **Monday to Saturday**.

If work is required outside these hours, affected neighbours will be notified in advance.

Work being done

- Establishing and operating temporary site compound
- Installing drainage and road infrastructure
- Sandy Creek bridge strengthening and upgrade works
- Signalling and track-related works
- Excavating ground
- Grubbing and vegetation removal, where required
- Asphaltting and line marking, where required
- Delivering construction equipment and materials to the site
- Mechanised track surfacing, also known as tamping
- Environmental monitoring, survey and track inspections
- Backfilling and reinstating affected areas
- Removing materials and debris off-site.

What can I expect?

- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration
- Heavy vehicles operating at the work site
- Reduced speed limit of 40km/h near works, where required

- On-site traffic management, where required. Please follow all instructions and signage.

Machinery used

Equipment includes but is not limited to hand tools, mobile crane, hi-rail machinery, generators, plate compactor, drum rollers, semi-trucks, loaders, EWP (elevated work platform), vibrating rollers, excavators, water carts, survey equipment, skid steer, power washer, heavy and light vehicles.

How we're managing impacts

- Where possible, non-tonal reversing alarms will be used on all equipment, and equipment will be switched off when not in use
- Traffic management controls will be in place where required to ensure the safety of vehicles and pedestrians. Please observe all traffic management instructions and signage
- Water carts will be on-site to dampen the ground and control dust
- Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum and show respect for our neighbours
- The works will be monitored to ensure compliance with the Project Conditions of Approval (CoAs) and the Environment Protection Licence (EPL 21984).

Work may be cancelled at short notice due to weather and other factors. If this happens, work will be rescheduled and affected neighbours will be notified in advance.

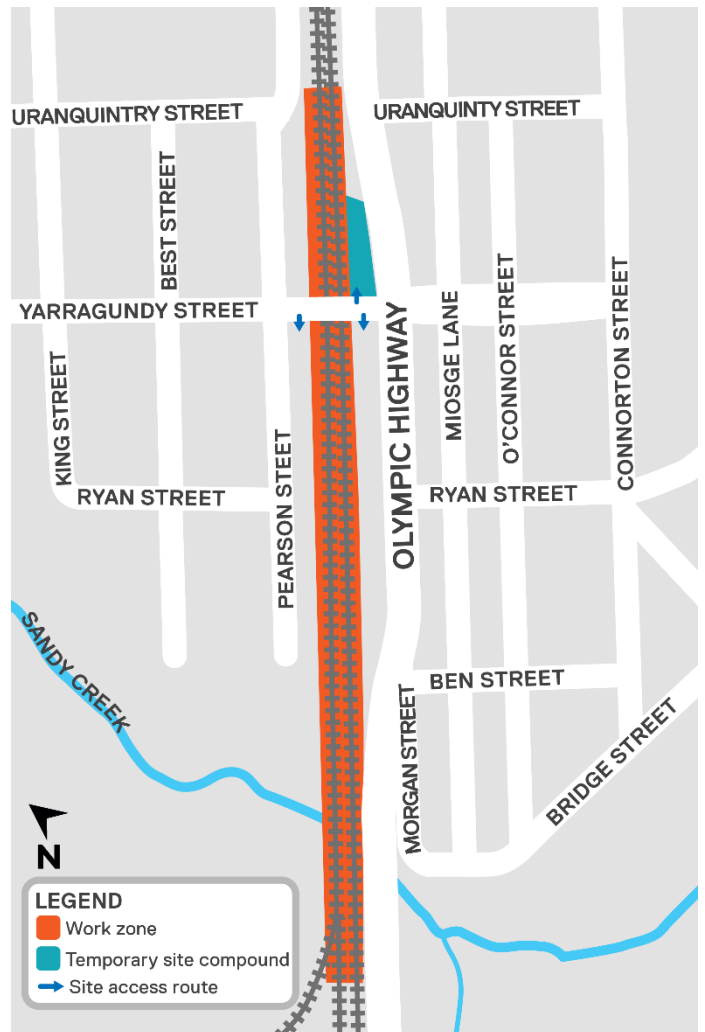
