Junee

September – November 2026

Martinus is continuing construction works across various sites in Junee.

Standard construction hours are 7am to 6pm **Monday to Saturday**. Out of hours work is sometimes required to work around trains running and based on track time.

Out-of-hours works

- 20 September – Sunday 6pm– 10pm
- 21 September – Monday 6pm– 10pm
- 4 October – Sunday 8am – 10pm
- 5 October – Monday 6pm - 10pm
- 18 October – Sunday 8am – 10pm
- 19 October – Monday 6pm - 10pm
- 25 October – Sunday 8am - 10pm
- 26 October – Monday 6pm - 10pm
- 2 November – Monday 6pm -10pm

Construction activities:

- Track works (ballasting, tamping and trench rolling)
- Movement of materials stockpiles and from site
- Geotechnical investigations
- Vegetation clearing and trimming as required
- Signalling installation works

Machinery used:

Heavy machinery including but not limited to track machinery, excavators, front end loader, generators, light vehicles, hand tools, watercarts and lighting towers.

What can I expect

- Excavation activities involving the removal of existing surfaces such as rock, soil, bridge segments, bridge abutments, existing roads and transportation of materials
- Heavy vehicle movements, geotechnical investigations and pavement coring.
- Loading, unloading and moving equipment including cranes and materials
- Construction machinery and equipment operation

Kemp Street footbridge girder delivery and installation

Out-of-hours works

- 28 September – 2 October 6pm – 10pm
- 6 October – 13 October 6pm – 10pm

Construction activities:

- Delivery and installation of 500 tonne crane, including delivery and installation of counterweights
- Delivery of pedestrian footbridge girders
- Traffic control and temporary road closure during mobilising, lifting and demobilisation.

Machinery used:

500 tonne crane, truck trailers with counterweights, elevated work platforms, lighting towers, light vehicles and hand tools.

What can I expect

- Hill Street and Edgar Street will be under
- traffic control with local resident access only
- during deliveries and closed during each girder
- lift off the trucks and into the corridor
- Pedestrian access to businesses on Hill Street will
- remain open.
- Site compound on Seignior Street and at Wrights
- Oval will be in use during the out of hours activities.

How we're managing impacts

- Works programmed to best minimise noise impacts.
- Use of low-tonal reversing alarms on all plant and equipment and turning off equipment when not in use.
- Instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum and being respectful of our neighbours.
- Water carts onsite to assist with dust suppression and fire risks.
- Onsite noise monitoring to be conducted to ensure compliance
- Traffic management will be in place to safely direct traffic as needed

Cancellation of works

Work may be cancelled at short notice due to weather and other factors. If this happens, work will be rescheduled and affected neighbours will be notified in advance.

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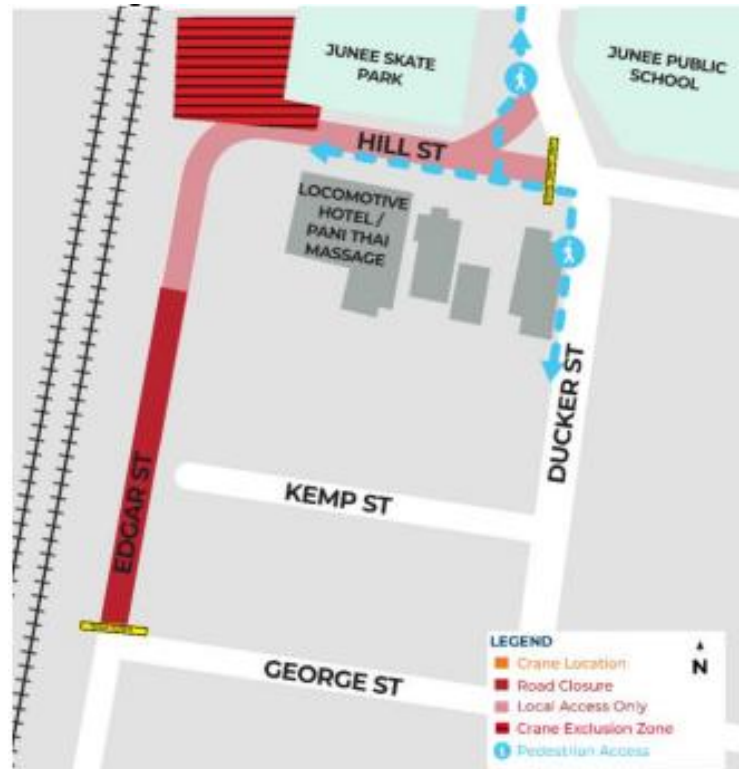
