

Cassidy Parade Footbridge

Works have reached an exciting milestone at the Cassidy footbridge, delivery and installation of the new bridge girders and ramps.

Works being done

The new bridge girders will be safely installed out of hours over the rail corridor while trains are not operating through the work area.

When will works occur

- 7am – 10pm Tuesday 6 October 2026
- 7am - 10pm Wednesday 7 October 2026 - main span lift
- 7am – 10pm Thursday 8 October 2026

Out of hours work permits are in place to allow work to continue until 10pm during this period. Work would only extend to this time where required by exception.

Bridge ramps and stairs will be installed during normal construction hours on Cassidy parade;

- 7am – 6pm Monday 12 October 2026
- 7am – 6pm Tuesday 13 October 2026

Machinery used

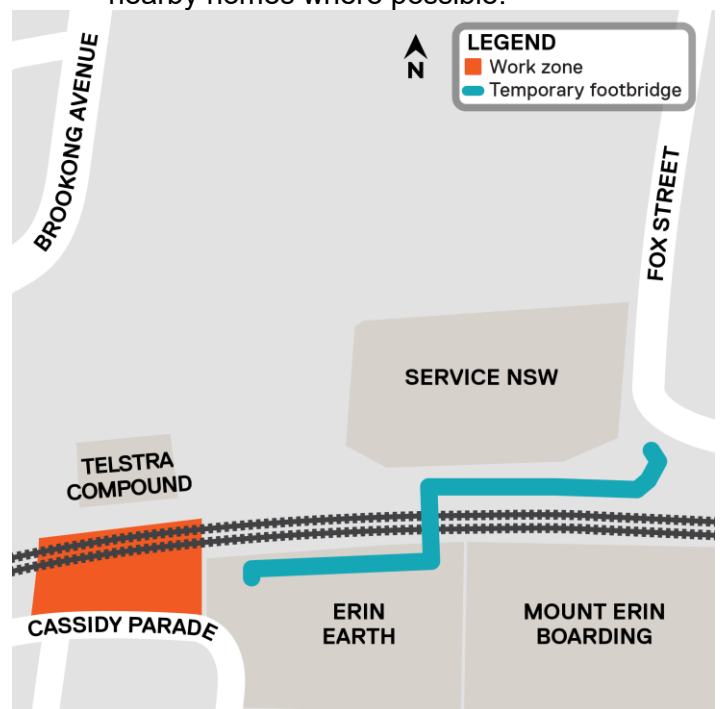
Mobile crane, 20 tonne Franna crane, trucks, light vehicles and lighting towers.

What can I expect?

- Some noise from cranes, trucks and delivery activities.
- Traffic control, short delays or changed traffic conditions near Cassidy Parade.
- Heavy vehicle movements, deliveries to site and temporary parking impacts near the work area.
- Lighting towers will be used during evening works and directed away from homes where possible.

How we're managing impacts

- Using traffic control to support safe vehicle movements and manage access around the work area.
- Turning off vehicles and equipment when not in use where safe and practical.
- Non tonal vehicle beepers
- Managing lighting to reduce spill towards nearby homes where possible.
