

Construction Update Yerong Creek September to November 2026



Martinus will continue construction works at Yerong Creek from **Tuesday, 1 September** to **Monday, 30 November 2026**, during standard construction hours of **7am to 6pm, Monday to Saturday**.

Track Possession Work

Martinus will also undertake out-of-hours work during an extended track possession at Yerong Creek from **6pm on Friday, 11 September** to **11:59pm on Tuesday, 15 September 2026**.

These works will be continuous, including night work throughout this period.

Track possessions are critical to the project, as no trains will run during this period. This helps us complete our work faster and minimise ongoing disruption to the community.

Work being done

- Operating the temporary site compound
- Excavating ground and track-related works
- Constructing a new pedestrian crossing at the Plunkett Street level crossing
- Installing new signalling infrastructure at the Plunkett Street level crossing
- Installing drainage and road infrastructure
- Asphaltting and line marking
- Environmental monitoring, survey and track inspections
- Delivering construction equipment and materials to the site
- Mechanised track surfacing, also known as tamping
- Removing materials and debris off-site.

What can I expect?

- **The Plunkett Street level crossing will be temporarily closed from 6pm Friday, 11 September 2026. It will reopen under temporary traffic control from 5am Monday, 14 September 2026, and will be fully reinstated by 6pm Tuesday, 15 September 2026**
- During the temporary road closure, the detour will follow the map overleaf. Please allow extra travel time during this period and follow all traffic controller instructions and signage
- Access for pedestrians will be maintained during the closure
- Reduced speed limit to 40 km/h near the work area
- Heavy vehicles operating at the work site
- Nearby residents may experience some noise and vibration.

Machinery used

Equipment includes, but is not limited to, hand tools, survey equipment, drilling rigs, semi-trucks and trailers, welding equipment, loaders, excavators, drum rollers, a compactor, water carts, power washer, skid steers, elevated work platforms (EWP), and heavy and light vehicles.

How we're managing impacts

- Water carts on-site to dampen the ground and help manage dust
- Non-tonal reversing alarms will be used on all equipment, and equipment will be switched off when not in use
- Traffic controls to ensure vehicle and pedestrian safety
- Workers will be instructed to keep noise to a minimum and show respect for our neighbours

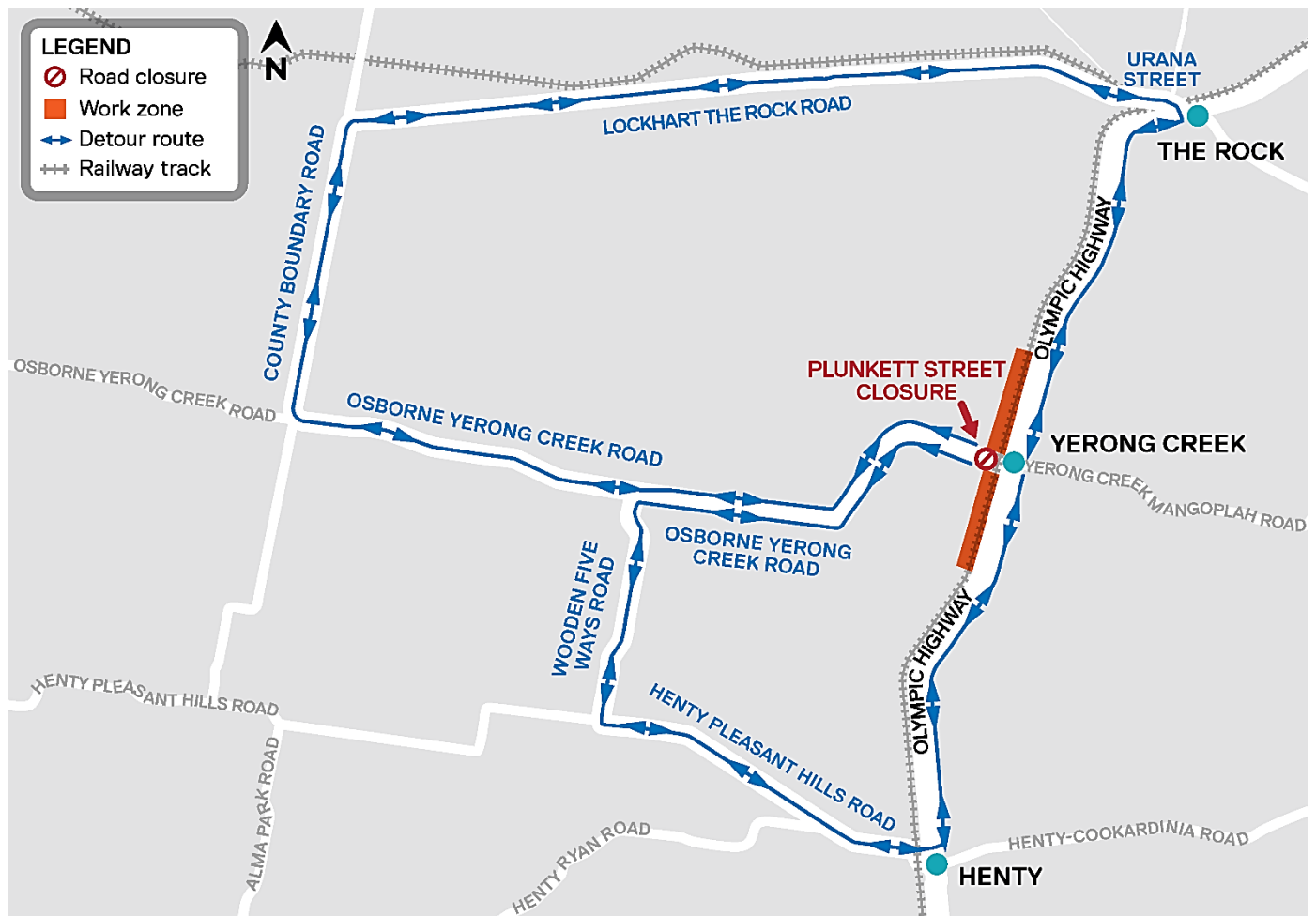
