Our contractor Martinus is continuing construction works across various sites in Junee during the month of September.

Upcoming Track Possession

Martinus will carry out track and associated works within the rail corridor in Junee during an extended track possession. Out-of-hours works will commence at various times as detailed below per site. Works will be continuous, including nightshift

At the completion of the track possession, construction hours will revert back to standard ours with the exception of approved out-of-hours periods.

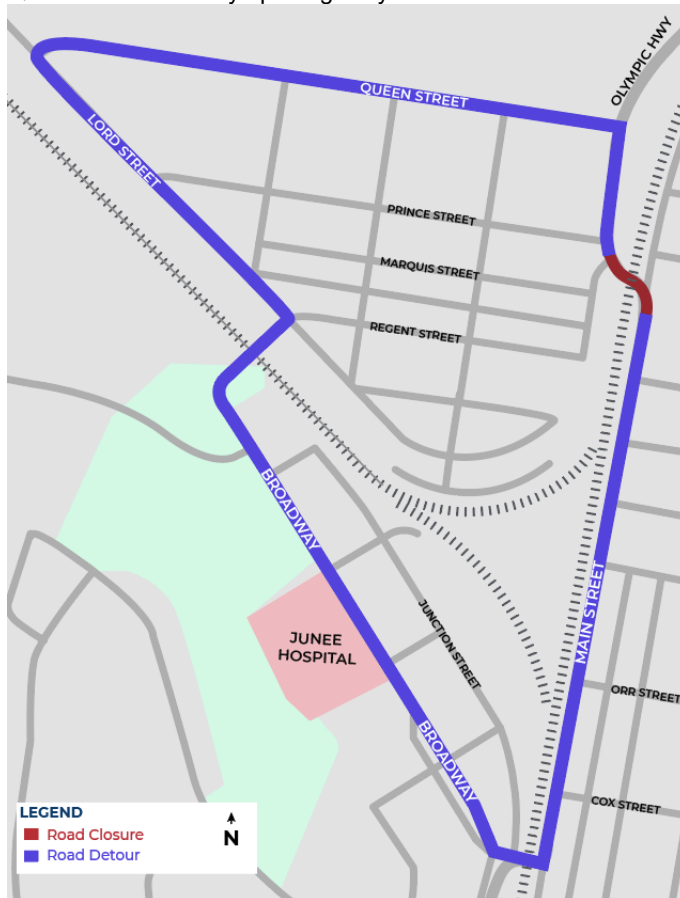
Olympic Highway under bridge

Track Possession

6pm Friday 11 September until 7am Thursday 17 September

- Installation of scaffolding under the bridge
- Removal and replacement of old timber transoms
- Track works including (readjusting, taming and de-stressing)
- Site compound operation and movements into laydown yards
- Geotechnical investigations
- **Olympic Highway under bridge will be closed from 6pm Friday 11 September until 6am Monday 14 September.**

Detours will be via Main Street, Broadway, Lord Street, Queen Street and Olympic Highway.



Out-of-hours construction

Key dates and times

- 6 September – Sunday 8am – 10pm
- 7 September – Monday 6pm – 10pm

Construction activities:

- Track works (tamping and trench rolling)
- Material transportation between sites
- Traffic control will be in place as needed
- Site compound operation
- Geotechnical investigations
- Vegetation clearing and trimming
- Signalling works

Junee Station Yard

Track Possession

6pm Friday 11 September until 7am Thursday 17 September

- Track work (crossover replacement, tamping and destressing)
- Geotechnical investigations
- Removal of the existing pedestrian footbridge at the station (Sunday 13 September only)

Out-of-hours construction

Key dates and times

- 6 September – Sunday 8am – 10pm
- 7 September – Monday 6pm – 10pm

Construction activities:

- Vegetation clearing
- Geotechnical and utility investigations
- Signalling installation works
- Track works
- Stockpile and material transportation between sites
- Drainage works

Kemp Street bridge

Track Possession

- **6pm Friday 11 September until 10pm**
- **7am Saturday 12 September until 10pm**
- **8am Sunday 13 September until 10pm Tuesday 15 September**

- Bridge deck construction including girder installation, formwork and reinforcements
- Minor scaffolding works
- Site compound operation (Wright's Oval)

Regular Construction activities:

- Steel girders to be delivered during September. Deliveries will occur on both the corner of Hill and Edgar Streets as well as within the Eastern Kemp Street compound (near Seignior Street)
- Asbestos removal may be necessary. Where identified, removals will be carried out by a licensed contractor with SafeWork NSW regulations.
- Abutment, pavement, kerb & footpath excavation, demolition and loadout
- Geotechnical investigations

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- Construction of concrete piers, retaining walls and other substructure elements
- Drainage and earthworks
- Utility investigation and relocation works
- Vegetation trimming, clearing and grubbing

Traffic Detours

Outside of track possession, vehicle detours will remain unchanged until project completion.

- Seignior Street will be partly closed; however the service road will remain open **for local traffic only**.
- Olympic Highway (Kemp Street) between Seignior Street and Joffre Street will remain local traffic access only in a west bound direction.
- The intersection of Railway Parade and Railway Lane will be closed

How we're managing impacts

- Works programmed to best minimise noise impacts.
- Use of non-tonal reversing alarms on all plant and equipment and turning off equipment when not in use.
- Instructing workers to keep noise to a minimum and being respectful of our neighbours.
- Water carts onsite to assist with dust suppression and fire risks.
- Onsite noise monitoring to be conducted to ensure compliance

What can I expect

Unfortunately, some construction activities are inherently noisy which cannot be avoided. Properties near these areas can expect to hear:

- Excavation activities involving the removal of existing surfaces such as rock, soil, bridge segments, bridge abutments, existing roads and transportation of materials
- Heavy vehicle movements, geotechnical investigations and pavement coring.
- Construction machinery and equipment operation
- Road and pedestrian detours
- An increase in deliveries of plant and materials to site compounds and stockpile locations.

Community Shuttle (map to the right)

Due to the closure of Olympic Highway Underbridge, there will be minor changes to the community shuttle.

Two new stops will be added onto Illabo Road (#5) and Cedric Street (#6) to maintain pedestrian access.

Hours of operation:

Saturday 12 September 7-12pm every 30 mins, 12-6pm hourly

Sunday 13 September 8-12pm every 30 mins, 12-6pm hourly

Equipment list

Heavy machinery including but not limited to track machinery, elevated work platforms, excavators, front end loader, generators, hand tools, watercarts and lighting towers.

Cancellation of works

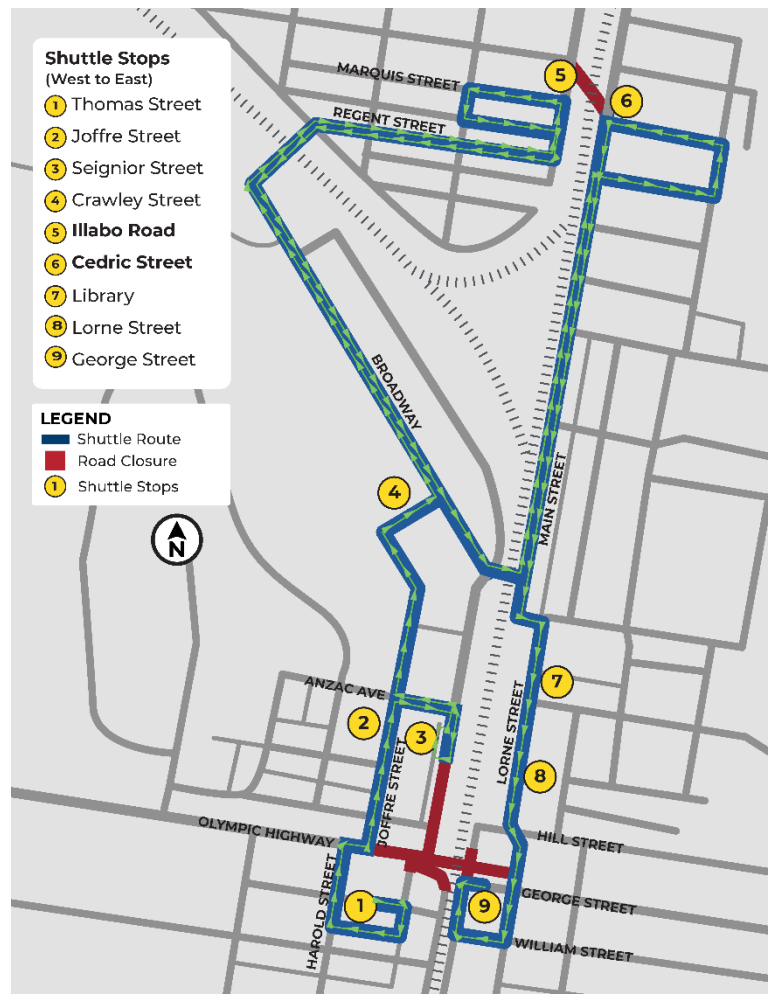
Work may be cancelled at short notice due to weather and other factors. If this happens, work will be rescheduled and affected neighbours will be notified in advance.
