1 Introduction

1.1 Background

The North Star to QLD Border, NSW (NS2B) project was determined to be a controlled action under the Commonwealth *Environment Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999* (EPBC Act) by the then Minister for Sustainability, Environment, Water, Population and Communities on 17 July 2018. The action was subsequently approved on 21 July 2023 (EPBC 2018/8222). The project is subject to the conditions of approval issued under EPBC 2018/8222, including the variation to the approved action accepted by the Minister under section 156B of the EPBC Act on 25 June 2020.

In addition to the EPBC approval, the project holds approval as Critical State Significant Infrastructure (CSSI) under Part 5, Division 5.2 of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979* (EP&A Act) for the construction and operation of the NS2B section of the Inland Rail Program. The CSSI approval was granted on 20 February 2023 and operates alongside, and complements, the conditions of the EPBC approval.

Inland Rail Pty Ltd (IRPL), a wholly owned subsidiary of the Australian Rail Track Corporation (ARTC), has not yet commenced the approved action as defined under the EPBC approval, comprising the upgrade, construction and operation of approximately 30 kilometres of rail infrastructure between North Star, New South Wales, and the NSW/Queensland border as part of the Inland Rail Program.

1.2 Scope

This report details the commitments outlined within EPBC 2018/8222 and assessment of compliance against conditions 1 - 42 for the reporting period 21 July 2025 to 20 July 2026 as per Condition 28-31 of EPBC 2018/8222, which states:

28) *The approval holder must prepare a compliance report for each 12-month period following the date of this approval, or as otherwise agreed to in writing by the Minister.*

29) *Each compliance report must be consistent with the Annual Compliance Report Guidelines, Commonwealth of Australia 2014.*

30) *Each compliance report must include:*

a) *Accurate and complete details of compliance and any non-compliance with the conditions and the plans, and any incidents.*

b) *One or more shapefile showing all clearing of any protected matters, and/or their habitat, undertaken within the 12-month period at the end of which that compliance report is prepared.*

c) *A schedule of all plans in existence in relation to these conditions and accurate and complete details of how each plan is being implemented.*

31) *The approval holder must:*

a) *Publish each compliance report on the website within 60 business days following the end of the 12-month period for which that compliance report is required.*

b) *Notify the department electronically, within 5 business days of the date of publication that a compliance report has been published on the website.*

c) *Provide the weblink for the compliance report in the notification to the department.*

d) *Keep all published compliance reports required by these conditions on the website until the expiry date of this approval.* e) *Exclude or*

redact sensitive ecological data from compliance reports published on the website or otherwise provided to a member of the public.

f) If sensitive ecological data is excluded or redacted from the published version, submit the full compliance report to the department within 5 business days of its publication on the website and notify the department in writing what exclusions and redactions have been made in the version published on the website.

1.3 Approved action

To date, the NS2B Project has only undertaken minor physical disturbance and has not commenced the action, as defined within EPBC 2018/8222.

The Australian Government has confirmed that Inland Rail is an important project to meet Australia's growing freight task, improve road safety and help decarbonise our economy.

In line with the Australian Government's response to the Independent Review of Inland Rail (undertaken by Dr Kerry Schott), ARTC is now taking a staged approach to deliver the Program of work. The sections of Inland Rail between Beveridge in Victoria and Parkes in New South Wales have been prioritised for completion by 2027. The section from Parkes to Narromine was delivered in late 2020. The delivery of these sections will enable Inland Rail to connect to existing rail networks between Melbourne, Sydney, Perth, Adelaide and the Illawarra via Parkes.

The immediate focus for ARTC north of Narromine is to preserve the rail corridor, which includes gaining primary approvals (which includes ARTC completing key environmental approval processes) and securing land required for the Inland Rail corridor. Future decisions by the Australian Government on the delivery of sections north of Narromine will be considered when it has more certainty around the delivery and full cost of the Inland Rail Program.

The key features of NS2B include:

- ▶ Approximately 25km of new track within existing rail corridor
- ▶ Approximately 5km of new track within greenfield rail corridor
- ▶ One crossing loop, turnouts at either end of the crossing loop and a one-ended siding
- ▶ Eleven new bridges including an approximately 1.8km long viaduct over the Macintyre River and Whalan Creek
- ▶ Reinforced concrete pipe culverts and reinforced concrete box culverts
- ▶ Realignment of Bruxner Way
- ▶ Ancillary infrastructure including utilities, signalling and communications infrastructure, fencing and signage.

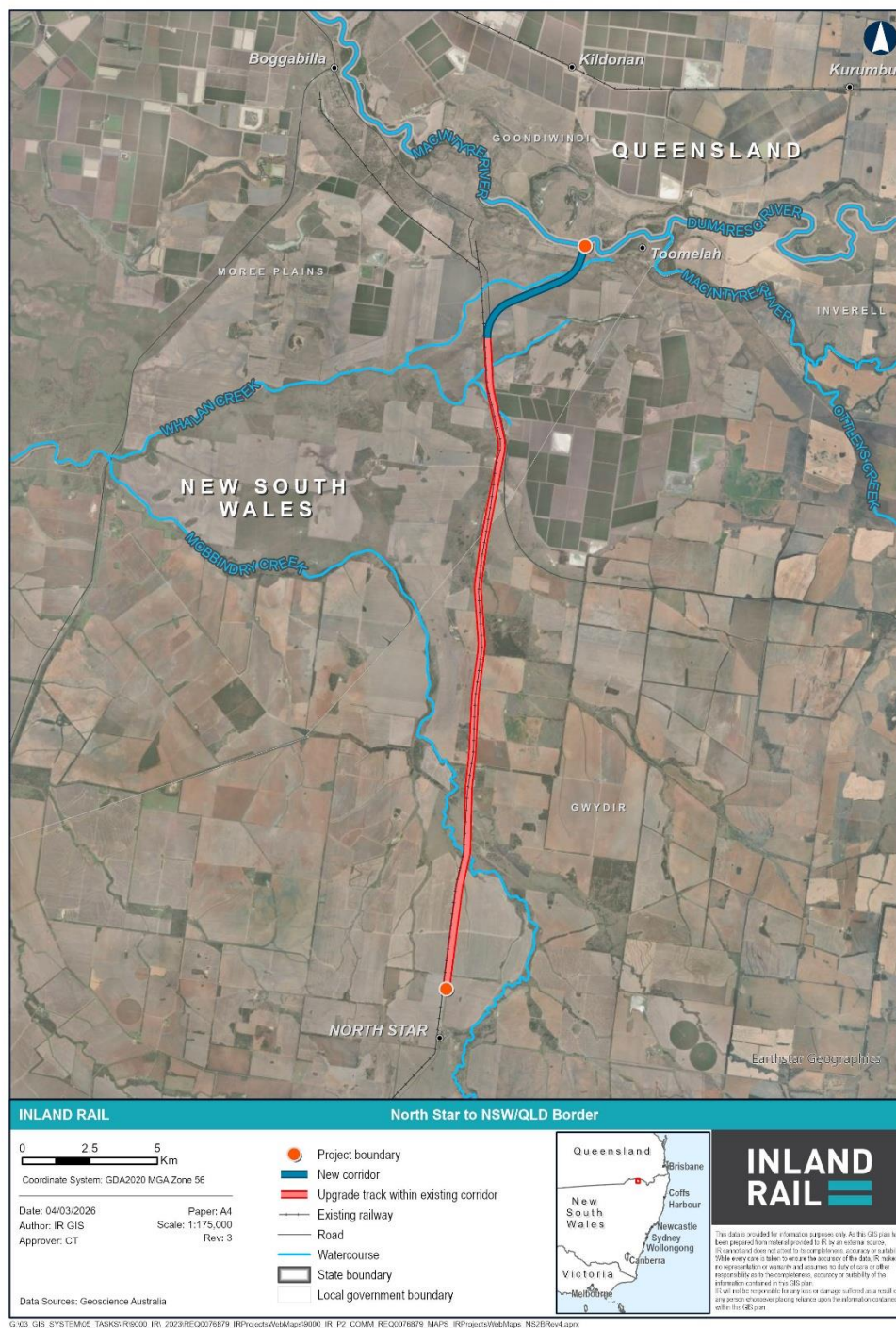


Figure 1 North Star to NSW/QLD border section of Inland Rail project footprint

The overall project footprint is presented in **Figure 1** below.

1.5 Key project activities

NS2B project activities to date have primarily focused on site investigations, design refinements and land acquisition negotiations to secure the Inland Rail corridor and inform future development.

IRPL are not currently undertaking Low Impact Works (LIW) scopes. Scopes which may be delivered prior to Construction include:

- ▶ Investigations, including investigative drilling and excavation
- ▶ Soil investigations
- ▶ Property acquisition adjustment work
- ▶ General survey investigations, including utilities investigations
- ▶ Other non-intrusive investigations.

2 Compliance assessment

2.1 Assessment of compliance

The terminology used to record findings in this compliance report (**Table 3**) is consistent with that used by the Commonwealth Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (DCCEEW-Comm.) Annual Compliance Report Guidelines (2014) Section 3.7.
